


Dear Friends of the Arts,



Great News for The Rockmart Theatre!!!

We are very excited that the **Appalachian Regional Commission** approved our grant request for the theatre! This one million grant will be used to renovate the theatre's façade, lobby, and life safety systems in the building. In addition to the ARC funds, local sources will provide \$442,000 bringing this project up to \$1,442,000. It was announced to the public on Facebook on October 3rd.

The City of Rockmart selected CEVIAN Design Lab through a competitive process to develop architectural drawings, bid documents, and inspection services for the renovation of the facility. We look forward to the return of the 1930s theatre to its original art deco beauty.

City Manager, Stacey Smith said "I would like to thank City staff, the Georgia Department of Community Affairs, the Appalachian Regional Commission, and Governor Brian Kemp for their efforts in making this funding opportunity a reality."

Georgia Council for the Arts approved a \$15,113 Cultural Facilities Grant to upgrade our theatre's curtains, sound equipment and stage lighting. They also gave us a \$3,600 Vibrant Communities grant to create a public art exhibit (tree carving) at the Lester House. We are very grateful for these much needed improvements!





Beginning Quilting with Dora Dryden


